Online registrations can be completed through the Equine City Hall, <http://equinecityhall.org>. Once at this site, click on the Horse Town Store button. After selecting the events you want to participate in, you will be prompted to login. If you've never logged into this site before, you must create a free "New Visitor Registration" account to be able to complete the entire registration process online.

#### EVENT REGISTRATION FEES

##### ON-LINE (Website) Prior to Expo Weekend:

- \$50 Event Registration: Competitors are required to work out of a stall. The \$50 registration fee includes 1 day-stall (no overnight) and 1 grounds admission ticket. *(Additional grounds admission tickets may be purchased for \$12.00 each.)*
- Division Fees: \$20.00 per run
- Jackpot Run: \$20.00 per run
- Parking is \$10/day and can be purchased separately online or upon arrival to the Expo. A 3-day parking pass may be purchased separately online for only \$25.

##### ON-SITE (at Expo) FEES

*Event registration will be allowed onsite with an additional administration fee of \$10.00 per run.*

- \$50 Event Registration: Competitors are required to work out of a stall. The \$50 registration fee includes 1 day-stall (no overnight) and 1 grounds admission ticket. *(Additional grounds admission tickets may be purchased for \$12.00 each.)*
- Division fees: \$30.00 per run
- Jackpot Run: \$30.00 per run
- Parking is \$10/day and can be purchased separately online or upon arrival to the Expo. A 3-day parking pass may be purchased separately online for only \$25.

#### STALL INFORMATION

Your \$50 registration fee includes 1 day-stall (no overnight.)

If an overnight stay is needed, another \$50 stall fee will apply. You can purchase the extra stall fee from the Equine City Hall – Horse Town Store shopping screen. Look for the item called "Day Stall in Barn" for \$50. This fee will allow your horse to spend Sat. night in the stall and depart on Sunday.

#### ARRIVAL/PARKING INFORMATION

- Gate 7 opens at 7:00 AM.

- Parking for trailers only is free in Lot C.
- Competitors can haul in any time after 7:00 AM on Sat, March 10<sup>th</sup>, which will allow your horse to settle in before the competition.
- Check-in/Registration will be from 2:30 PM – 4:30 PM.

## EVENT INFORMATION

- Jackpot Runs:
  - Anyone can ride!
  - 100% Pay out, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placements
- Division Runs – Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placements
  - Lead Line (up to 6 years of age)
  - Youth (7- 16 yrs. of age)
  - Novice (Beginner Riders 17+)
  - Amateur (Intermediate Riders)
  - Open (Experienced riders)
  - Classics (65+ of age)
  - Pro (Professional Horseman \$1000/year)

**\*\*\*\*\*NO HORSES ARE ALLOWED INTO COMPETITION ARENA!\*\*\*\*\***

**If any contestant enters either arena with their horse prior to competition they will be immediately disqualified with NO refund. The only exception to this would be working with a scheduled clinician in that arena prior to Colorado Obstacle Challenge Series event.**

- There will be a photographer at this Event. Details to follow.
- Please be prepared to write a short bio on the rider and horse at check- in for the announcer.
- Order of go will be by random draw, with online registrations riding last. If riding multiple horses, spacing for tack change will be allowed.
- Walk through at 5:00 PM PROMPT – Questions and answers for the judges at walk through.
- First Division start time 5:45 PM.
- No judge fraternization after walkthroughs until awards completed for your division.
- Award presentation to be held in Arena after all Divisions are complete.
- Concessions available.
- Water is available on site for your horse(s) – Bring your own bucket.
- Warm up area is available. Ask at Check-in/Registration if unsure where to warm up.
- **NO DOGS allowed!**
- Scoresheets will be available for viewing after awards. A competitor may take a photo of their scoresheet but cannot take the scoresheet. If a competitor takes their scoresheet, there is no way to record their points for the 2018 series. Make sure not to take them with you!
