On behalf of the Rocky Mountain Horse Expo, we would like to invite your drill team to the 1st Annual Rocky Mountain Horse Expo Drill Team Showcase. The showcase will be held on Sunday, March 11th, 2018 beginning at 3pm at the National Western Stock Show Complex Event Center. The purpose of this competition is to allow drill teams to get the experience of riding at The Event Center in a show, as well as being able to meet your fellow drill team/equestrian enthusiasts from the Rocky Mountain region. The Rocky Mountain Expo will be advertising and selling tickets to this event.

If your team decides to participate, each rider will be given a Rocky Mountain Horse Expo day pass for the day of the competition, which will allow you to attend all of Sunday's clinics, horse auctions, entrance to the trade floor, and of course the showcase.

The showcase will have two divisions: One "Main Drill" and one "Patriotic Drill." Each team will have the opportunity to perform twice on Sunday. The divisions will cost \$150.00 to enter. This fee will include: day passes for each rider, parking pass, stalls for the day, and entry fee for riders and coaches on Sunday only, as well help with the purchase of awards for winning teams. If you have family, friends, and fans coming to cheer you on, they will need to purchase a day pass or a ticket to this event, as well as pay for their parking.

Please look over the application and respond as soon as you have made the decision to participate. Please complete your application and submit it by **February 15th 2018**. Proof of Insurance and Payments will need to be received **NO LATER THAN February 15st 2018**.

Horses must meet the following Colorado Horse Council- RMHE Requirements:

Horses who do not have these requirements will not be allowed on the show grounds or to compete.

- Horses are required to have a 30-Day Health Certification from a State Certified Veterinarian
- Horses are required to have a CURRENT Coggins if coming in from out of state
- Horses are required to have a brand inspection or travel card if traveling more than 75 miles to get there
- Horse are required to be in good condition with the proper weight and ability to perform

Stall Information:

- The Rocky Mountain Horse Expo will be provided free stalls on SUNDAY the 11th ONLY.
- The stalls will be limited to ONLY the horses performing in the competition. You will not be allowed to bring horses that are not competing.
- Shavings will NOT be provided
- Stalls must be cleaned out when you are finished using them. Manure is to be dumped in designated manure areas.
- There will be no extra tack or food stalls available.
- Feel free to decorate stalls with horse names, rider names, or advertise your team. Please do not use strong tape or glue that would damage the stall.
- Please keep Isles CLEAN as expo visitors routinely stroll the stall areas to look at horses.

Required Insurance Coverage/Liability Release:

ALL riders are REQUIRED to sign a RMHE liability release. Please make copies of the release attached and ensure that all team members sign. They will be collected at check in to the event.

If your group belongs to the Colorado Horse Council, your membership includes insurance coverage. It is REQUIRED by the Rocky Mountain Horse Expo that teams cover their own liability insurance. You will need to provide a certificate of insurance required for general liability in the amounts of \$1 million each occurrence and \$2 million general aggregate. The policy must meet the minimum requirements of The Rocky Mountain Horse Expo.

Please attach your proof of membership or certificate of insurance with the application or send BEFORE February 15th 2018; for RMHE approval.
