This Event is a volunteer opportunity to fulfill End Of Year High Point Saddle requirements.

Online registration is required, You must set up an account in Equine City Hall which is free of charge. You will then be able to complete the entire registration process online.

Pre registration for this Event *is required* for stall planning by Expo.

Use drop down for 2020 Horse Expo. Click on Shopping for Expo. It will bring up a page that will have links for everything you could need for everything Expo! Clinics, passes for all events, parking, stalls, Anything you may need!

To register for COCS event on March 1st ONLY, click on Colorado Obstacle Challenge Series link. Follow prompts, clicking on next at the bottom of each page as you complete the required information. You will see a page that has every Division on it, as well as a 1 day stall if you are choosing to attend only our Event on Sunday. ***If you are already staying and attending other Events and have already paid for a stall for Sunday, no need to obtain another stall.***

Event registration will be allowed onsite for riders *already registered for other activities* with additional administration fee of \$5.00 per run.

Division fees: \$25.00 online registration, \$30.00 on site registration

Jackpot Run: \$20.00

Competitors are required to work out of a stall. Stall fee of \$50.00 will include 1 grounds pass. Separate grounds admission can be purchased for \$12.00. Stall fee covers 7 am of day you arrive to 7 am of following morning.

If you want to stay for all 3 days and attend clinics, it is recommended to purchase the 3 day package through Rocky Mountain Horse Expo.

Jackpot Runs \$20 (Anyone can ride! 100% Pay out, 1st, 2nd and 3rd Places)

Division Runs \$25 for online registration, \$30.00 for onsite registration (Ribbons 1st, 2nd, and 3rd)

- Lead Line (up to 6 years of age)
- Youth (7- 13 yrs. of age)
- Novice (Beginner Riders 14+)
- Green Horse 1 (Green horses under the age of 5)

- Green Horse 2 (Green horses over the age of 5 on a case by case basis)
- Amateur (Intermediate Riders)
- Open (Experienced riders)
- Classics (65+ of age)
- Pro (Professional Horseman \$1000/year)

Check in 8:00am – 9:00am for Youth, Novice, Green Horse 1 and 2 and Amateur Divisions. Walkthrough at 9:30.

Check in 11:00am – 12:00pm for Leadline, Open, The Classics, and Pro Divisions. Walkthrough after Amateur Division is finished.

Jackpot walktrough to follow Pro.

Questions and answers for the judges at walk through.

No judge fraternization after walkthroughs until awards completed for your division.

Award presentation to be held by Arena after all Divisions for that day are completed

Water is available on site for your horse(s) – Bring your own bucket.

Warm up area is available. Ask at registration/ check in if unsure where to warm up.

NO Dogs are allowed.

Scoresheets will be available for viewing after awards. A competitor may take a photo of their scoresheet but cannot take the scoresheet. If a competitor takes their scoresheet, there is no way to record their points for the 2020 series. Make sure not to take them with you!
